



The Eastern Polk Quilters' Guild was organized in January 2001 for the purpose of promoting an interest in quilts and quilt-making; striving to provide educational and entertaining programs, and offering opportunities for stimulating exchanges of ideas and creativity.

Our Present...

The organization is open to all persons 12 and older with an interest in guilts and guilt-making. The Guild meets the third Monday of each month at 7:00 p.m., 12 months a year. Meetings are held at the Lutheran Church of the Cross, Altoona, Iowa. Adult membership dues (19 years and older) are \$25.00 annually (January – December). Junior Membership dues (12 through 18 years of age) are 50% of the adult membership. Guest fee is \$5.00 and may be applied to membership dues if joining at that same meeting.

Meetings generally consist of a brief meeting, a program speaker or demonstration and guild members' "Show & Tell". Members volunteer each month to bring refreshments for social time.
